of Project	Habitat for Humanity, a global NGO which dedicates to the elimination of inadequate
	housing, launched a project called "Big Builds" in Asia Pacific. It is the overseas
	volunteer program that hundreds of volunteers from all over the world get together
	and build tens of houses at once in short period of time.
	This summer the event is called "Rebuild Sri Lanka" and takes place in Sri Lanka
	where Habitat Japan also has on-going projects. The construction site is in
	Negombo, located along the coast of southwest Sri Lanka. 24 houses will be built in
	one week together with 300 volunteers from all over the world.
	People in Sri Lanka are trying to rebuild their lives after the civil war and Indian Ocean
	Tsunami in 2004, which damaged hundreds of thousands of houses. 24 families that
	will live in these houses have also been suffered from this tsunami. They do not have
	their houses, and have to live under unsanitary condition. Although their income is
	very limited, they have been working hard and have got land where they will build their houses with Habitat.
	"Rebuild Sri Lanka" is a special project which builds houses to support the local
	families who are rebuilding their lives after civil wars and natural disasters.

	 * Recommended points * Since volunteers gather not only from Japan but from all over the world, you can make friends with people from various countries. On your free time, you can refresh your body on the beach of Negombo which is famous as a beach resort!

*1 Deadline

-We may close the recruitment even before the deadline when the number of applicants reach the quota.

*2 Accommodation

-The room will be twin or triple/ (separated by gender) in principal. Your roommate will be arranged by Habitat. If you have a preference, please inform us when you submit the application form. However there's a possibility we won't be able to meet your request.

-If you prefer a single room with additional cost of ¥20,000, please inform us when you submit the application form.

-Please arrange your accommodation before and after the program by yourself.

*3 Local support system

-Local Habitat staff and volunteer staff will support you such as picking up at the airport and transporting to hotel.

*4 Cancellation policy

① If individual volunteer must cancel the trip

We cannot refund application fee (¥50,000) once the fee was paid. Cancellation made by June 19 will result in ¥50,000 (Application fee). Cancellation made after June 20 will result in all of your payments.

② If HABITAT FOR HUMANITY must cancel the trip

In case the safety condition worsens in the hosting country or community, Habitat for Humanity will cancel the tirp and refund the payment. We cannot compensate you for any other expenses.

* Please refer to the policy of a travel agent regarding to the travel expenses (air fare booked by yourself, oversea insurance)

*5 Airline ticket

- Habitat Japan can also book your flight with only following schedule.

August 2nd departure from Narita – August 13th arrival in Narita, direct flight by Sri Lankan Airlines (UL) We will arrange hotel on August 2nd, 3rd, 11th, and transportation between airport and hotel as well. Charge: 123,000 yen (A round trip airline ticket Narita – Colombo:¥110,000, 4 nights hotel fee plus transportation fee: ¥13,000)

Due to the limited number of the seats, we might not be able to meet your request.

* Cancellation policy: As for the air tickets Habitat arrange, cancellation fee of ¥30,000 will occur only after the ticket is issued. As for the 4 nights hotel plus transportation fee, regulation of participation fees (see about the above-mentioned *4 cancellation policy) shall be followed.

*6 Insurance

-Although the insurance Habitat provides covers any illness and injury during the construction activity, this is only minimum coverage and not comprehensive that theft of the baggage, damage caused by delay of the airplane are not covered. We recommend you to join overseas travel insurance individually. Please click here for more details.

*7 Visa

-A visa is necessary to enter into Sri Lanka. Please acquire one in person.
